## AN ACT

SB 833

Amending the act of February 1, 1966 (P.L.1656, No.581), entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending and consolidating the law relating to boroughs," further regulating the salaries of mayors.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1025, act of February 1, 1966 (P.L.1656, No.581), known as "The Borough Code," amended October 19, 1967 (P.L.451, No.206), is amended to read:

Section 1025. Salary of Mayor Limited.—The salary of the mayor shall not exceed, per annum, **[three hundred dollars (\$300)]** four hundred fifty dollars (\$450) for the first one thousand population or fraction thereof, the population to be determined by the latest official census figures. In any borough with population in excess of one thousand the salary of the mayor shall not exceed **[two hundred dollars (\$200)]** three hundred dollars (\$300) per annum per thousand population or fraction thereof, the population to be determined by the latest official census figures.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
