Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to counties of the second class and second class A; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," increasing expense and travel allowances.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 435, act of July 28, 1953. (P.L.723, No.230), known as the "Second Class County Code," amended October 25, 1967 (P.L.483, No.229), is amended to read:

Section 435. Expenses of Attending; Members to be Paid by County; Time Limit on Meetings.—(a) The [actual reasonable] expenses of all authorized county officers [authorized to attend] attending the annual meetings of their associations [, including hotel bills,] shall be paid by the [county] several counties out of general county funds. [Such expense shall not exceed thirty-five dollars per day] Each of these officers may be allowed for his expenses up to fifty dollars (\$50) per day for the number of days specified in subsection (b) of this section, together with [ten] twelve cents per mile in going to [, attending] and returning from such meeting. The expense allowance shall be paid for each day not in excess of two in going to and returning from such meeting.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
