Designating a portion of a highway in Luzerne County as the Arthur Gardner Highway.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. That portion of Legislative Route 1133 from New Coxeville to Hazle Village in Luzerne County ¹opened to traffic in September of 1971 shall be officially designated and known as the Arthur Gardner Highway in honor of the first serviceman killed in World War II.

Section 2. The Secretary of Transportation shall erect suitable markers in order to carry out the provisions of this act.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
