Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," authorizing certain persons to receive compensation for services rendered evenings or Saturdays during the school term to certain colleges or universities and making an editorial correction.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1007, act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the "Public School Code of 1949," amended January 14, 1970 (P.L.468, No.192), is amended to read:

Section 1007. Not to Engage in Teaching; Exceptions.—No executive director of the intermediate unit, district, or assistant district superintendent or assistant executive director of an intermediate unit in this Commonwealth shall engage in the business or profession of teaching in this Commonwealth, unless it is done without any other compensation than that paid to him as such superintendent: Provided, That he may receive compensation for services in a summer school, maintained in a State [teachers'] college or university, or other college or university, devoted to the training of teachers, or for services rendered evenings or Saturdays during the school term, to any such college or university, if he is released for such service by the board of school directors of the district in which he is employed.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
