Amending the act of April 29, 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), entitled "An act consolidating and revising the Vehicle Code, the Tractor Code, the Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility Act and other acts relating to the ownership, possession and use of vehicles and tractors," reducing to eighteen years of age the minimum age requirement of persons who may operate a motor bus.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 605, act of April 29, 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), known as "The Vehicle Code," amended May 29, 1968 (P.L.132, No.70), is amended to read:

Section 605. Age Limits for Drivers of School Buses and Public Passenger Carrying Motor Vehicles.—It shall be unlawful for any person, who is under the age of [twenty-one (21)] eighteen (18) years, to operate a motor vehicle of the bus type in the transportation of pupils to or from school, or to operate a motor bus or motor omnibus in the transportation of passengers. [except that a motor bus having a capacity of not more than six (6) passengers may be operated by a person between the ages of eighteen (18) and twenty-one (21) years.]

Penalty.—Any person violating any of the provisions of this section, shall, upon summary conviction before a magistrate, be sentenced to pay a fine of ten dollars (\$10.00) and costs of prosecution, and, in default of the payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment for not more than five (5) days.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
