REORGANIZATION PLAN NO. 2 OF 1973

Section 1. The functions, powers and duties of the Department of Public Welfare with regard to the supervision and licensing of special and general hospitals, as set forth in Articles 9 and 10 of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the "Public Welfare Code," are hereby transferred to the Department of Health.

Section 2. There are hereby transferred to the Department of Health to be used, employed, and expended in connection with the functions, powers and duties transferred by section 1 of this Reorganization Plan, contract obligations, if any, records, files, property, supplies and equipment now being used or held in connection with such functions, powers and duties, and the unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations and other funds available or to be made available for use in connection with such functions, powers and duties.

Section 3. Articles 9 and 10 of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the "Public Welfare Code," are hereby suspended in so far as they conflict with this Reorganization Plan.

(Reorganization Plan No. 2 of 1973, transmitted to the General Assembly on April 2, 1973, was approved by a majority vote of the duly elected membership of each House of the General Assembly, the last approval having occurred on May 22, 1973.)
