Amending the act of May 14, 1949 (P.L.1342, No.402), entitled "An act relating to and regulating the business of dry cleaning and dyeing, as herein defined; granting authority to, and imposing duties upon, the Department of Labor and Industry; requiring approval by said department of certain plans for dry cleaning and dyeing plants and the machinery, equipment and systems used therein; prescribing filing fees for applications for said approval; providing for certain administrative and judicial review of the orders and decisions of said department; conferring authority upon certain employees of political subdivisions and representatives of the Pennsylvania State Police; providing penalties for violations of the provisions of this act or the regulations adopted thereunder; and repealing certain acts," increasing the filing fee for applications for approval of plans.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The last paragraph of section 12, act of May 14, 1949 (P.L.1342, No.402), known as the "Dry Cleaning and Dyeing Law," is amended to read:

Section 12. Approval of Plans for Dry Cleaning and Dyeing Plants.—* * *

A fee of [five (\$5) dollars] forty-eight (\$48) dollars shall be paid to the department at the time any application for approval shall be filed.
