SB 596

Providing for the capital budget for the fiscal year 1973-1974.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Construction.—This act and its supplements shall constitute the “Capital Budget Act of 1973-1974 Fiscal Year.” The provisions and definitions of the act of July 20, 1968 (P.L.550, No.217), known as the “Capital Facilities Debt Enabling Act,” unless inconsistent herewith, shall apply.

Section 2. Overall Limitations on Debt to be Incurred for Capital Projects.—The maximum principal amount of additional debt to be incurred hereafter during the 1973-1974 fiscal year and thereafter until the enactment of the 1974-1975 capital budget specifying such maximum debt for the 1974-1975 fiscal year, for capital projects specifically itemized in a capital budget pursuant to clause (4) of subsection (a) of section 7 of Article VIII of the Constitution of Pennsylvania, and the fund to be charged with the repayment of such debt shall, with respect to each category of capital projects, be as follows:

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 1973.
