## AN ACT

HB 851

Authorizing the Supervisors of Indiana Township, Allegheny County, to transfer certain Project 70 lands in Allegheny County to the Department of Transportation for a widening and reconstruction project under certain conditions.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the requirements of subsection (b) of section 20, act of June 22, 1964 (Special Session No. 1, P.L. 131, No. 8), known as the "Project 70 Land Acquisition and Borrowing Act," the General Assembly authorizes the Supervisors of Indiana Township, Allegheny County, to transfer the hereinafter described land in Indiana Township in Allegheny County to the Department of Transportation for right-of-way for construction of Project L.R.679, Section A07, involving widening and reconstruction of Traffic Route 910.

Such land shall be free of the restrictions on use and alienation prescribed by section 20 of the act of June 22, 1964 (Special Session No. 1, P.L. 131, No. 8), known as the "Project 70 Land Acquisition and Borrowing Act," upon:

- (1) Payment to the township in an amount equal to the fair market value of the land transferred; or
- (2) Acquisition by the Department of Transportation of suitable replacement land, at the option of the township; and
- (3) Execution and filing of a document of transfer and release, citing such payment or acquisition, transfer and release of the said land from the restrictions on use and alienation prescribed by subsection (b) of section 20 of said act.

The document of transfer and release in such cases shall, upon such reimbursement, or acquisition, be approved by the Department of Justice and filed in the office of the recorder of deeds of the county in which the said land is located. Compliance with this subsection constitutes the express approval of the General Assembly of release of the restrictions on use or alienation of lands acquired by the Department of Transportation required by subsection (b) of section 20 of said act.

Section 2. The land to be transferred by the Supervisors of Indiana Township, Allegheny County, to the Department of Transportation for a right-of-way for construction of Project L.R.679, Section A07, to widen and reconstruct Traffic Route 910 is more particularly described as follows:

### Description of Highway Project

Project L.R.679, Section A07, beginning at a point on existing L.R.679, T.R.910, in Harmar Township at the interchange of the Allegheny Valley Expressway with T.R.910. The project proceeds in a northwesterly direction on the present alignment of the road through the community of Indianola, crossing over the Pennsylvania Turnpike twice on existing structures and terminates at the intersection of T.R.910 with Saxonburg Boulevard in Indiana Township, a distance of approximately 4.4 miles.

### Description of Required Project 70 Lands

The Project 70 land required for the above highway project comprises about 1.49 acres located approximately between Station 203 + 47 and Station 209 + 80. The highway right-of-way will have a maximum width of 250 feet, more or less.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
