## AN ACT

SB 359

Amending the act of July 20, 1917 (P.L.1158, No.401), entitled "An act to fix, regulate, and establish the fees to be charged and received by constables in this Commonwealth," changing the fee for serving a complaint in landlord and tenant proceedings.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. So much of section 1 as relates to service of a complaint in landlord and tenant proceedings, act of July 20, 1917 (P.L.1158, No.401), entitled "An act to fix, regulate, and establish the fees to be charged and received by constables in this Commonwealth," amended December 28, 1972 (P.L.1641, No.344), is amended to read:

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That, from and after the passage of this act, the fees to be charged and received by constables in this Commonwealth shall be as follows:

For serving complaint in landlord and tenant proceedings, [**two dollars fifty cents.**] *five dollars.*

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
