Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," authorizing assistant district attorneys in all counties and providing for their salaries.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1420, act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), known as "The County Code," is amended to read:

Section 1420. Assistant District Attorneys; Number; Compensation.—[In counties of the third, fourth, fifth and sixth classes the] *The* district attorney may appoint such number of assistants, learned in the law, to assist him in the discharge of his duties, as is fixed by the salary board of the county. The salary board shall fix the salary of [each] such [assistant] assistants.
