## AN ACT

SB 576

Amending the act of March 27, 1903 (P.L.105, No.84), entitled "An act rendering women eligible to the office of commissioner to take acknowledgment of deeds and instruments of writing under seal," reducing certain age requirements.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1, act of March 27, 1903 (P.L.105, No.84), entitled "An act rendering women eligible to the office of commissioner to take acknowledgment of deeds and instruments of writing under seal," is amended to read:

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That from and after the passage of this act, women, being [twenty-one] eighteen years of age, shall be eligible to the office of commissioner to take the acknowledgment of deeds and instruments of writing under seal; and the Governor of this Commonwealth is hereby authorized to appoint and commission them as commissioners, in each or any of the States of the United States, or in the District of Columbia, as he may deem it expedient.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
