## AN ACT

## SB 1100

Amending the act of June 22, 1931 (P.L.594, No.203), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," changing a route in Indiana County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Route 32038, act of June 22, 1931 (P.L.594, No.203), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," amended December 5, 1967 (P.L.674, No.314), is amended to read:

Route 32038. Beginning at a road intersection [approximately 1.25 miles northeast of the village of Mechanicsburg in Brush Valley Township, Indiana County; thence northeasterly through Brush Valley Township a distance of approximately 1.45 miles; beginning again] in Cherryhill Township at an intersection with Township Road 746; thence northeasterly through Cherryhill Township to a point on Route 301 in the village of Pikes Peak; thence northerly to a point on State-aid Application 4597 in the village of Penn Run, a distance of approximately 3.22 miles [, a total distance of approximately 4.67 miles] in [Brush Valley and] Cherryhill [Township] Township, Indiana County.
