Amending the act of June 12, 1973 (P.L.56, No.24), entitled "A supplement to the act of October 11, 1972 (P.L.911, No.217), entitled "An act providing for the capital budget for the fiscal year 1972-1973," itemizing emergency life safety public improvement projects to be constructed by The General State Authority, together with their estimated financial costs," increasing a project and adding a project.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Clause A, and the total authorization and project (39) of Subdivision I of Clause B of section 2, act of June 12, 1973 (P.L.56, No.24), known as the "Capital Budget Act for Fiscal Year 1972-1973, Public Improvement Project Itemization Supplement, Emergency Life Safety Code Improvements—The General State Authority," Clause A and the total authorization of Subdivision I of Clause B amended October 10, 1974 (P.L.725, No.244), are amended and Subdivision I of Clause B of section 2 is amended by adding a project to read:

Section 2. Itemization and Authorization of Projects.—Additional capital projects in the category of public improvement projects to be constructed by The General State Authority, its successors or assigns, and to be financed by the incurring of debt, are hereby itemized, together with their respective estimated financial costs and the total additional amount authorized for public improvement projects, as follows:

Section 2. The additional \$1,170,000 for the improvements to Shamokin State General Hospital and the Marcy State School and Hospital shall be provided from excess funds available in the unallocated reserve of the Capital Facilities Fund.
