Amending the act of May 18, 1945 (P.L.809, No.323), entitled "An act removing certain roads or sections of road from the State highway system; and providing for their future maintenance and construction," removing a route in Indiana County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1.1, act of May 18, 1945 (P.L.809, No.323), entitled "An act removing certain roads or sections of road from the State highway system; and providing for their future maintenance and construction," added October 11, 1951 (P.L.1657, No.440), is amended to read:

Section 1.1. The following described roads, which were added to the State highway system under the provisions of the act, approved the twenty-fifth day of June, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one (Pamphlet Laws 1369), entitled "An act establishing certain State-aid highways and concrete township reward roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations, and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act; and repealing an act," are hereby removed from the State highway system:

The section of road in Bristol Township, Bucks County, presently identified in the records of the Department of Highways as Application 4947; beginning at a point on the eastern line of Bristol Borough and extending northeastwardly, a distance of about one-tenth of a mile to a road intersection.

The section of road in Falls Township, Bucks County, presently identified in the records of the Department of Highways as Application 5610; extending southerly from the Morrisville Borough line, a distance of 2.37 miles to a road intersection.

The section of road in White Township, Indiana County, presently identified in the records of the Department of Transportation as Application 527B; beginning at the intersection of L.R. 32053 and extending northwardly, a distance of 670 feet to its junction with Township Road 488, a distance of about one-tenth of a mile.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
