Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for violation of rules and regulations regarding conduct on Commonwealth property.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Title 18, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is amended by adding a section to read:

- § 7506. Violation of rules regarding conduct on Commonwealth property.
- (a) Promulgation of rules and regulations.—The Department of Environmental Resources, Game Commission, and Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission may promulgate rules and regulations governing conduct, other than conduct regulated in section 7505 (relating to violation of governmental rules regarding traffic), on Commonwealth property within the jurisdiction of that agency. Such rules and regulations shall be reasonably related to the preservation and protection of such property for its specified or intended use, or to promote the welfare, safety or protection of those persons using such property, shall be consistent with existing law and shall be posted in a manner reasonable likely to come to the attention of persons using such property.
- (b) Violation penalty.—A person who violates any of the rules and regulations promulgated pursuant to this section is guilty of a summary offense.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
