## AN ACT

HB 1220

Amending the act of April 13, 1972 (P.L.184, No.62), entitled, "An act giving municipalities the right and power to adopt home rule charters or one of several optional plans of government and to exercise the powers and authority of local self-government subject to certain restrictions and limitations; providing procedures for such adoption and defining the effect thereof," providing for the disposition of the records of a government study commission.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 210, act of April 13, 1972 (P.L.184, No.62), known as the "Home Rule Charter and Optional Plans Law," is amended by adding a subsection to read:

Section 210. \* \* \*

(d) All the records, reports, tapes, minutes of meetings and written discussions of the government study commission shall, upon its discharge, be turned over to the municipal clerk or secretary for permanent safekeeping and made available for public inspection at any time during regular business hours.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
