## AN ACT

HB 2420

Amending the act of July 14, 1961 (P.L.637, No.329), entitled "An act relating to the payment of wages or compensation for labor or services; providing for regular pay days; conferring powers and duties upon the Department of Labor and Industry, including powers and duties with respect to the civil collection of wages; providing civil and criminal penalties for violations of the act; providing for their collection and disposition and providing for additional civil damages," requiring certain employers to furnish certain information concerning computation of wages at time of payment.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of July 14, 1961 (P.L.637, No.329), known as the "Wage Payment and Collection Law," is amended by adding a section to read:

Section 4.1. Computation of Wages by Railroads.—

- (a) Every common carrier by railroad shall furnish to each of its employes at the time of payment a separate listing of each daily wage and how it was computed.
- (b) The department shall issue rules and regulations to carry out the intent of subsection (a) and provide penalties for violation thereof, not to exceed two hundred dollars (\$200) per employe per month.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
