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Amending the act of May 11, 1949 (P.L.1210, No.367), entitled "An act relating to group life insurance; describing permitted policies and restrictions thereon, the premium basis thereof and rights thereunder; limiting the amount of such insurance; prescribing standard policy provisions; and requiring notice of conversion privileges," further providing for the amount for which a creditor may insure a debtor.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

- Section 1. Clause (4) of section 3, act of May 11, 1949 (P.L.1210, No.367), entitled "An act relating to group life insurance; describing permitted policies and restrictions thereon, the premium basis thereof and rights thereunder; limiting the amount of such insurance; prescribing standard policy provisions; and requiring notice of conversion privileges," amended March 23, 1970 (P.L.206, No.83), is amended to read:
- Section 3. Policies Issued to Creditors.—A policy issued to a creditor to insure debtors of the creditor shall be subject to the following requirements:
- (4) The amount of insurance on the life of any debtor shall at no time exceed the amount owed by him which is repayable in instalments to the creditor, or [thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000)] sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) whichever is less.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
