## AN ACT

SB 1367

Amending the act of June 22, 1931 (P.L.594, No.203), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," amending a route in Chester County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. As much of route 15037 as established in section 16, act of June 22, 1931 (P.L.594, No.203), referred to as the Township State Highway Law, is amended to read:

Section 16. The township roads to be taken over, under the provisions of this act, in the County of Chester, are those situate and described as follows:

\* \* \*

Route 15037. Beginning at a point on the Pennsylvania-Delaware State Line about .3 of a mile southwest of the New Garden-Kennett Township line; thence northerly through New Garden Township to a point on Route 215 near Station [1835] 932 at Kaolin; thence easterly through New Garden and Kennett Townships to [a point on State-aid Application 245 near Station 120,] the intersection with Route 15038 in Chester County, a distance of about [3.7] 2.6 miles.

\* \* \*

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
