Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for the retention of certain receipts relative to snowmobile registration.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 7706 of Title 75, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is amended to read:

- § 7706. Restricted receipts fund.
- (a) Deposit and use of moneys.—The department shall deposit all moneys received from the registration of snowmobiles, the sale of snowmobile registration information, snowmobile publications and other services provided by the department, all fines and penalties resulting from violations of this chapter, and all fees collected under this chapter in a restricted receipts fund, from which the department shall draw moneys for use in carrying out the registration, safety education and enforcement requirements of this chapter as well as the establishment, construction and maintenance of trails and any equipment and supplies necessary to carry out the purposes of this chapter. All moneys in said fund not heretofore paid into the General Fund shall remain in said restricted receipts fund to be used as specified in this chapter.
- (b) Audit [and lapse] of moneys.—The restricted receipts fund shall be audited every two years. [with any residue appearing in the fund at the end of each auditing period to be deposited in the General Fund.]

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1979.
