AN ACT

HB 178
Amending the act of June 1, 1933 (P.L.1172, No.290), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," transferring routes to Lewisburg Borough, Union County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Routes 59024 and 59037 of section 2, act of June 1, 1933 (P.L.1172, No.290), referred to as the Borough State Highway Law, route 59037 added June 25, 1937 (P.L.2279, No.440), are deleted as follows:

Section 2. The streets taken over under the authority of this act are situate and described as follows:

Union County

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Lewisburg Borough
[Route 59024. Extending Route 59024.-Beginning at a point on Route 628, at the intersection of Third and Saint Anthony Streets, in the borough of Lewisburg, thence in a northeasterly direction on Saint Anthony Street to the Lewisburg Borough-Kelley Township line, Union County, a distance of about 28 of a mile.]
[Route 59037. Extending Route 59037.-Beginning at a point on the East Buffalo Township-Lewisburg Borough line; thence over Brown and Third Streets to the intersection of Routes 26, 259, and 628, at Third and Market Streets, in the borough of Lewisburg, Union County, a distance of about 0.64 of a mile.]

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Section 2. On or after the effective date of this act, the roads herein described shall be maintained, constructed and reconstructed by the authorities of the Borough of Lewisburg.

Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
