## AN ACT

### HB 650

Amending the act of June 1, 1933 (P.L.1172, No.290), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," deleting a route in Marietta Borough, Lancaster County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The following route in Lancaster County in section 2, act of June 1, 1933 (P.L.1172, No.290), referred to as the Borough State Highway Law, is deleted:

Section 2. The streets taken over, under the authority of this act are situate and described as follows:

[Traffic Route 404; Route 36004. Extending Route 36004.—Beginning at a point on the Marietta Borough-East Donegal Township-line, thence in a southerly direction on North Bank Avenue to an intersection with State Highway Route 280, at North Bank Avenue and Market Street, in the borough of Marietta, Lancaster County, a distance of about .11 of a mile.] \* \* \*

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
