Amending the act of June 1, 1933 (P.L.1172, No.290), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," deleting a route in Lewisburg Borough, Union County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. As much of section 2 as relates to Route 59037 in Lewisburg Borough, Union County, act of June 1, 1933 (P.L.1172, No.290), referred to as the Borough State Highway Law, added June 25, 1937 (P.L.2279, No.440), is deleted as follows:

Section 2. The streets taken over under the authority of this act are situate and described, as follows:

# UNION COUNTY

# Lewisburg Borough

[Route 59037. Extending Route 59037.—Beginning at a point on the East Buffalo Township-Lewisburg Borough line; thence over Brown and Third Streets to the intersection of Routes 26, 259, and 628, at Third and Market Streets, in the borough of Lewisburg, Union County, a distance of about 0.64 of a mile.]

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
