Amending the act of August 5, 1941 (P.L.752, No.286), entitled "An act regulating and improving the civil service of certain departments and agencies of the Commonwealth; vesting in the State Civil Service Commission and a Personnel Director certain powers and duties; providing for classification of positions, adoption of compensation schedules and certification of payrolls; imposing duties upon certain officers and employes of the Commonwealth; authorizing service to other State departments or agencies and political subdivisions of the Commonwealth in matters relating to civil service; defining certain crimes and misdemeanors; imposing penalties; making certain appropriations, and repealing certain acts and parts thereof," adding positions in the Vocational Education Management Information Systems to the classified service in the Department of Education.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Subclause (7) of clause (d) of section 3, act of August 5, 1941 (P.L.752, No.286), known as the "Civil Service Act," amended August 27, 1963 (P.L.1257, No.520), is amended to read:

Section 3. Definition of Terms.—In this act, unless the context otherwise clearly requires,—

- * * :
- (d) "Classified service" includes:

* * *

(7) All positions now existing or hereafter created in the Department of [Public Instruction,] Education, including positions in the Vocational Education Management Information Systems and excluding the presidents, faculty members and student employes of the State colleges, the heads and faculty members of the department's other educational institutions and excluding also county superintendents, assistant county superintendents and supervisors of special education;

* * *

- Section 2. (a) The following positions and incumbents occupying positions in the following program are hereby placed in the Department of Education: Vocational Education Management Information Systems.
- (b) The incumbents of these positions shall be governed by all of the appropriate personnel rules, regulations and policies as other Department of Education employes, and the incumbents of these positions shall be granted probationary status and serve the probationary period appropriate for their classifications as provided for in section 603 of the act.
- (c) The Department of Education shall provide for the integration, training, employment and classification of all current Bureau of Information Systems employes who are engaged in functions associated with the Vocational Education Management Information Systems program in

accordance with the written agreement entered into between the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employes and the Department of Education on April 29, 1981.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
