Amending the act of July 24, 1941 (P.L.490, No.188), entitled "An act relating to acknowledgments of written instruments, and to make uniform the law with relation thereto," providing for acknowledgments by an attorney at law.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 7, act of July 24, 1941 (P.L.490, No.188), known as the "Uniform Acknowledgment Act," is amended by adding a clause to read:

Section 7. Forms of Certificates.—An officer taking the acknowledgment shall endorse thereon or attach thereto a certificate substantially in one of the following forms:

* * *

(5) By an attorney at law— State of..... County of.....

In witness whereof, I hereunto set my hand and official seal.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
