# AN ACT

HB 1291

Amending the act of December 5, 1980 (P.L.1665, No.138A), entitled "An act to further provide for the expenses of the Executive and Legislative Departments of the Commonwealth for the fiscal period July 1, 1980 to June 30, 1981; to make additional appropriations from the Federal Revenue Sharing Trust Fund and the Motor License Fund and making certain repeals," adding an additional appropriation to the Department of Public Welfare from the General Fund and increasing the appropriation to the Department of Education from the Federal Revenue Sharing Trust Fund.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. As much as relates to the Executive Department in section 1 and as much of section 3 as relates to the Department of Education, act of December 5, 1980 (P.L.1665, No.138A), entitled "An act to further provide for the expenses of the Executive and Legislative Departments of the Commonwealth for the fiscal period July 1, 1980 to June 30, 1981; to make additional appropriations from the Federal Revenue Sharing Trust Fund and the Motor License Fund and making certain repeals," are amended to read:

Section 1. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the General Fund to the several hereinafter named agencies of the Executive and Legislative Departments of the Commonwealth for the payment of salaries, wages or other compensation and travel expense of the duly elected or appointed officers and employees of the Commonwealth, for payment of fees of contractual services rendered, for the purchase or rental of goods, services, printing, equipment, land and buildings and for payment of any other expenses, as provided by law or by this act, necessary for the proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities and for the purposes hereinafter set forth for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 1980 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1980.

(b) The appropriations in sections 1 and 2 insofar as they relate to the Pennsylvania Crime Commission, the Department of Public Welfare and the Legislative Management Committee (R) of the Senate are supplemental appropriations to be added with the appropriations made pursuant to the act of June 18, 1980 (P.L.1391, No.17A) or the act of June 30, 1980 (P.L.1441, No.22A).

# A SUPPLEMENT

## HB 712

To the act of July 1, 1981 (No.48), entitled "An act to provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal period July 1, 1981 to June 30, 1982, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1981; itemizing appropriations of the Federal Augmentation to the Executive and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, establishing restricted receipts accounts for the fiscal period July 1, 1981 to June 30, 1982 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1981 and to provide additional and supplemental appropriations from the General Fund and the Motor License Fund to the various departments of the Commonwealth for the fiscal period July 1, 1980 to June 30, 1981," itemizing appropriations required from the Motor License Fund for the proper operation of the several departments of the Commonwealth authorized to spend Motor License Fund moneys.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. This supplement shall be known and may be cited as the "Motor License Fund Supplement to the 'General Appropriation Act of 1981.'"

Section 2. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the Motor License Fund to the hereinafter named agencies of the Commonwealth for the payment of salaries, wages and other compensation and travel expenses of the duly elected or appointed officers and employees of the Commonwealth, for contractual services and other expenses necessary for the proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities for the purposes hereinafter set forth for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 1981 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1981.

In addition to the amounts appropriated by this act, all moneys received from the Federal Government or from any other source as contributions to or payments for the programs provided herein shall be paid into the Motor License Fund and are hereby appropriated out of the Motor License Fund for the purposes and programs intended.  Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 1981, or if enacted subse-

This item is approved in the amount of \$513,447,000. I withhold my approval on the remainder of this item.

The reduction in this appropriation is necessary since, when the budget bill was prepared, it was not anticipated that the "Oil Company Franchise Tax Act' would require that Philadelphia not receive a reduction in funding as a result of the preemption by that tax measure of a similar local tax that was to take effect in that city July 1. This line item reduction will hold \$4,500,000 available to provide the funds required for that purpose.

# AN ACT

SB 893

Making an appropriation from the Public School Employees' Retirement Fund to provide for expenses of the Public School Employees' Retirement Board for the fiscal period July 1, 1981 to June 30, 1982 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1981.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The sum of \$6,016,000, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated from the Public School Employees' Retirement Fund to the Public School Employees' Retirement Board for the payment of all salaries, wages and other compensation and travel expenses of the employees and members of the Public School Employees' Retirement Board, for contractual services and other expenses necessary for the proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities of the board for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 1981 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1981.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

#### AN ACT

SB 894

Making an appropriation from the State Employees' Retirement Fund to provide for expenses of the State Employees' Retirement Board for the fiscal period July 1, 1981 to June 30, 1982 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1981.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The sum of \$3,801,000, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated from the State Employees' Retirement Fund to the State Employees' Retirement Board for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 1981 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1981 for the payment of all salaries, wages and other compensation and travel expenses of the employees and members of the State Employees' Retirement Board, for contractual services including the fees for mortgage supervision, money management, control of investments and other expenses necessary for the proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities of the board and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1981.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1981.
