## AN ACT

## HB 1582

Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled "An act concerning townships of the second class; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," further providing for attendance at certain conferences, institutes and schools.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (h) of section 516, act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), known as "The Second Class Township Code," reenacted and amended July 10, 1947 (P.L.1481, No.567), and amended June 27, 1973 (P.L.67, No.28), is amended to read:

Section 516. Duties of Supervisors, Township Superintendents, and Roadmasters.—The township supervisors, or the supervisors employed as superintendents or roadmasters, shall

\* \* \*

(h) Attend [road] meetings and conventions [authorized by the provisions of this act when] if directed to do so by the board of supervisors. Any supervisor, elected or appointed officer or [qualified] township employe [may] shall, if directed by the board of supervisors, attend any conference, institute or school [conducted within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in order to discuss and resolve the various questions arising in the discharge of the duties and functions of the respective officers and employes, and to provide uniform, efficient and economical methods of administering their township duties] dealing with the duties and functions of such elected or appointed officers or employes. The expenses for attending the conferences, institutes and schools may be paid by the township and shall be limited to the registration fee, mileage [at the rate of twelve cents (12c) per circular mile, and thirty-five dollars (\$35)] going to and returning from such meeting plus all other expenses not to exceed sixty dollars (\$60) per day.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 30 days.
