AN ACT

SB 1300

Providing for adoption of capital projects to be financed from current revenues of the Boating Fund, Fish Fund, Farm Products Show Fund and the Dormitory Fee Reserve Fund.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Itemization and adoption of additional projects.

Additional 1981-1982 Capital Budget Projects in the category of public improvement projects, to be financed from current revenues of the Boating, Fish, Farm Products Show and Dormitory Fee Reserve Funds pursuant to executive authorizations and to be constructed and/or acquired by the Pennsylvania Fish Commission, the Department of Agriculture and the Department of Education are hereby itemized together with their respective estimated costs, as follows:
