Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," providing for retention of records as photographed, microphotographed or microfilmed copies.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 518, act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the "Public School Code of 1949," is amended to read:

Section 518. Retention of Records.—Every board of school directors shall retain as a permanent record of the district, the minute book, each annual auditor's report, and each annual financial report. All other financial records of the district, including financial account books, orders, bills, contracts, invoices, receipts, and purchase orders shall be retained by the district for a period of not less than six years. Records may be retained as photographed, microphotographed or microfilmed copies in accordance with the act of January 18, 1968 (1967 P.L.961, No.428), known as the "Municipal Records Act."

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
