SB 526

Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for annual assessments for district attorneys' associations.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (a.1) of section 445, act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), known as "The County Code," added June 24, 1976 (P.L.443, No.107), is amended to read:

Section 445. Annual Assessments for County Commissioners, Etc.—***

(a.1) In addition to the expenses hereinbefore authorized, the necessary expenses of the association of district attorneys shall be apportioned among the counties holding membership in the association in amounts provided for by the rules and regulations of the association but shall not total per annum more than:

(1) **[three hundred dollars (\$300)]** *one thousand dollars (\$1,000)* for any county of the third class;

(2) **[two hundred fifty dollars (\$250)]** *eight hundred dollars (\$800)* for any county of the fourth class;

(3) **[two hundred dollars (\$200)]** *five hundred dollars (\$500)* for any county of the fifth class;

(4) **[one hundred fifty dollars (\$150)]** *three hundred fifty dollars (\$350)* for any county of the sixth class;

(5) **[one hundred dollars (\$100)]** *two hundred dollars (\$200)* for any county of the seventh class; or

(6) **[fifty dollars (\$50)]** *one hundred dollars (\$100)* for any county of the eighth class.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
