Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to counties of the second class and second class A; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for annual assessments for district attorneys' associations.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (a.1) of section 437, act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), known as the "Second Class County Code," added June 24, 1976 (P.L.446, No.108), is amended to read:

Section 437. Annual Assessments for County Commissioners, Etc.—\*\*\*

(a.1) In addition to the expenses hereinbefore authorized, the necessary expenses of the association of district attorneys shall be apportioned among the counties holding membership in the association in amounts provided for by the rules and regulations of the association but shall not total per annum more than [four hundred dollars (\$400)] one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1,200) for counties of the second class or second class A.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
