Repealing the act of June 10, 1907 (P.L.523, No.329), entitled "An act extending and defining the liability of employers, in actions for negligence, for injury or death of their employes; declaring what shall not be a defense in such actions by employes against their employers, and defining who are agents of the employer, under this act."

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of June 10, 1907 (P.L.523, No.329), entitled "An act extending and defining the liability of employers, in actions for negligence, for injury or death of their employes; declaring what shall not be a defense in such actions by employes against their employers, and defining who are agents of the employer, under this act," is repealed.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
