Amending the act of January 19, 1968 (1967 P.L.996, No.443), entitled "An act authorizing the creation of indebtedness of five hundred million dollars for the conservation and reclamation of land and water resources; defining the powers and duties of certain offices, agencies and political subdivisions; providing for the allotment of proceeds hereunder including Commonwealth grants; prescribing standards and making appropriations," reappropriating lapsed funds.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 20(g) of the act of January 19, 1968 (1967 P.L.996, No.443), known as The Land and Water Conservation and Reclamation Act, added October 10, 1980 (P.L.921, No.158), is amended to read:

Section 20. Appropriations.—***

(g) All moneys lapsed under clause (4) of subsection (a) of section 16 are hereby appropriated for four fiscal years beginning July 1, 1979, to the Department of Community Affairs for the purposes specified in clause (4) of subsection (a) of section 16. Expenditures from such appropriation shall not be subject to the limitation set forth in subsection (c) of section 16. The balance of the foregoing appropriation, together with such other appropriations made for the purpose of clause (4) of subsection (a) of section 16, which remains unexpended, unencumbered, or uncommitted after June 30, 1983, shall [lapse] not lapse but shall remain to the credit of the Department of Community Affairs until expended in accordance with the provisions of this appropriation.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
