## AN ACT

HB 1726

Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled "An act concerning townships of the second class; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," further providing for attendance at certain conferences, institutes and schools.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 516(h) of the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), known as The Second Class Township Code, reenacted and amended July 10, 1947 (P.L.1481, No.567) and amended March 1, 1982 (P.L.123, No.39), is amended to read:

Section 516. Duties of Supervisors, Township Superintendents, and Roadmasters.—The township supervisors, or the supervisors employed as superintendents or roadmasters, shall—

\* \* \*

(h) Attend meetings and conventions if directed to do so by the board of supervisors. Any supervisor, elected or appointed officer or township employe shall, if directed by the board of supervisors, attend any conference, institute or school dealing with the duties and functions of such elected or appointed officers or employes. The *actual* expenses for attending the conferences, institutes and schools may be paid by the township and shall be limited to [the registration fee, mileage going to and returning from such meeting plus all other] actual expenses not to exceed [sixty dollars (\$60)] ninety dollars (\$90) per day plus the registration fee and mileage going to and returning from such meetings.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 30 days.
