Amending the act of June 18, 1974 (P.L.359, No.120), entitled "An act creating the Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training Commission; providing for the commission's membership, selection, compensation, and removal; providing for the powers and duties of the commission; providing for the appointment and duties of the chairman; providing for the act's applicability to the civil service laws; requiring training by certain political subdivisions and police departments; providing penalties for violation thereof; and making an appropriation," further providing for reimbursement of certain expenses.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 10 of the act of June 18, 1974 (P.L.359, No.120), referred to as the Municipal Police Education and Training Law, is amended by adding a subsection to read:

Section 10. Reimbursement of Expenses.—* * *

(d) If a police officer, within two years following certification, terminates his employment with the political subdivision by which he was employed at the time he was duly certified as having met the commission's requirement and thereafter obtains employment as a police officer with another political subdivision, the political subdivision which employs the previously certified police officer shall reimburse the political subdivision which formerly employed the police officer for the nonreimbursable portion of the salary paid to the police officer while complying with the provisions of this act.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
