## AN ACT

HB 1301

Amending the act of November 4, 1983 (P.L.217, No.63), entitled "An act establishing a program of limited pharmaceutical assistance for the elderly; granting powers to and imposing duties on the Department of Aging; establishing a payment system; making provisions for funding; providing for reports; and fixing penalties for violations of the pharmaceutical assistance program," changing maximum annual income requirements.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The definition of "maximum annual income" in section 3 of the act of November 4, 1983 (P.L.217, No.63), known as the Pharmaceutical Assistance Contract for the Elderly Act, is amended to read:

Section 3. Definitions.

The following words and phrases when used in this act shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

\* \* \*

"Maximum annual income." Annual income as determined by the department. Such amount shall not exceed [\$9,000] \$12,000 in the case of single persons nor [\$12,000] \$15,000 in the case of the combined annual income of married persons.

\* \* \*

Section 2. This act shall take effect April 1, 1985.
