Amending the act of November 1, 1971 (P.L.495, No.113), entitled "An act providing for the compensation of county officers in counties of the second through eighth classes, for the disposition of fees, for filing of bonds in certain cases and for duties of certain officers," increasing the salary of county officers holding two or more offices.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 2 of the act of November 1, 1971 (P.L.495, No.113), entitled "An act providing for the compensation of county officers in counties of the second through eighth classes, for the disposition of fees, for filing of bonds in certain cases and for duties of certain officers," reenacted and amended October 7, 1976 (P.L.1101, No.223) and amended November 1, 1979 (P.L.246, No.82), is amended to read:

Section 2. The annual salaries of sheriffs shall be as follows:

In those classes of counties in which the sheriff also acts as a warden, the county commissioners may, at their discretion, compensate such sheriffwarden an additional two thousand dollars (\$2,000) for holding said dual positions. The periodic salary increases provided for in section 10.1 of this act shall be applicable to this section.

Section 2. Section 11 of the act is amended to read:

Section 11. Where any of the officers herein mentioned hold two or more of the offices for which a salary is herein fixed, he shall receive the highest salary fixed for any one of the offices which he holds, plus an additional amount of [one thousand dollars (\$1,000)] two thousand dollars (\$2,000) per annum. The periodic salary increases provided for in section 10.1 of this act shall be applicable to this section.

Section 3. This act shall be applicable to any such officer when permitted by the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
