Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," authorizing appropriations for neighborhood crime watch programs.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1502 of the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as The First Class Township Code, reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569), is amended by adding a clause to read:

Section 1502. The corporate power of a township of the first class shall be vested in the board of township commissioners. The board shall have power—

LXXV. Appropriations for Neighborhood Crime Watch Programs. To appropriate annually, solely at the discretion of the board, an amount toward a neighborhood crime watch program. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no township or official thereof shall become subject to contractual, tort or other liability as a result of having made an appropriation pursuant to this clause.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
