Amending the act of January 18, 1952 (1951 P.L.2128, No.605), entitled "An act defining and providing for the licensing and regulation of private driver education or training schools; conferring powers and imposing duties on the Department of Public Instruction; and imposing penalties," further providing for the vehicles used in practical driver training.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 4(3)(d) of the act of January 18, 1952 (1951 P.L.2128, No.605), referred to as the Private Driver Education or Training School Act, amended July 31, 1963 (P.L.403, No.210), is amended to read:

Section 4. The qualifications for licensure and the standards of licensure.

* * *

(3) Instructional Equipment and Materials.

* * *

(d) Every [car] vehicle used for practical driver training shall be a recent model, not more than five (5) years old or having not more than fifty thousand (50,000) miles, whichever occurs later, with special equipment as follows: operable extra brake pedal, and in the case of vehicles equipped with standard transmission an operable extra clutch pedal, defroster and heater in working order, rear-view mirror placed on the inside of the car in the vicinity of the cowl, two (2) outside rear-view mirrors, one on each side of the vehicle, and cushions for the proper seating of the students.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
