Amending the act of December 13, 1982 (P.L.1127, No.257), entitled "An act requiring every Commonwealth agency to award certain fees and expenses in certain agency actions and providing for appeals from decisions of an adjudication officer," extending the expiration date of the act.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

- Section 1. Section 6 of the act of December 13, 1982 (P.L.1127, No.257), referred to as the Commonwealth Agency Adjudicatory Expenses Award Law, amended June 30, 1987 (P.L.175, No.18), is amended to read: Section 6. Effective date.
- (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), this act shall take effect July 1, 1983.
 - (b) Section 4 shall take effect immediately.
- (c) This act shall expire [July 1, 1997] July 1, 2007, unless sooner reenacted or amended.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
