## AN ACT

## **HB 38**

Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in governance of the system, further providing for establishment of fees and charges and for costs; in facilities and supplies, further providing for surcharge; and, in budget and finance, further providing for Commonwealth portion of fines.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

- Section 1. Sections 1725(c)(3)(ii), 1725.1(a)(4) and (7), 3571(c)(2)(vi) and (vii) and 3733.1(a)(1) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- § 1725. Establishment of fees and charges.
  - (c) Counties of the first class.—
  - (3) The fees to be received by the prothonotary on behalf of the Philadelphia Municipal Court in civil actions shall be as follows:

§ 1725.1. Costs.

- (a) Civil cases.—Subject to subsection (f), the costs to be charged by magisterial district judges in every civil case, except as otherwise provided in this section, shall be as follows:
  - (4) Actions involving more than \$4,000 but not more than \$75.00 [\$8,000] \$12,000......
- § 3571. Commonwealth portion of fines, etc.
  - (c) Costs in magisterial district judge proceedings.—
    - (2) Amounts payable to the Commonwealth:
      - - (D) More than \$4,000 but not more than [\$8,000]

§ 3733.1. Surcharge.

- (a) Imposition of surcharge.—In addition to each fee imposed under section 3733(a.1) (relating to deposits into account), except as set forth in subsection (b), the following apply:
  - (1) A surcharge of \$11.25 shall be charged and collected [for a period of 25 months beginning on the effective date of this section]. This paragraph shall expire December 31, 2014.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
