Designating Byberry Avenue from Warminster Road to York Road, Borough of Hatboro, Montgomery County, as the SP4 Robert Preston Ruttle, Jr., Memorial Highway.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. SP4 Robert Preston Ruttle, Jr., Memorial Highway.

(a) Findings.—

(1) Robert Preston Ruttle, Jr., a resident of Hatboro, Montgomery County, began his tour of duty in Vietnam on November 15, 1968, as a Specialist 4 with the 101st Airborne Division.

(2) On June 5, 1969, SP4 Ruttle, age 23, was killed in Quang Tin Province by an enemy explosive device while valiantly serving his country.

(b) Designation.—Byberry Avenue from Warminster Road to York Road, Borough of Hatboro, Montgomery County, is hereby designated the SP4 Robert Preston Ruttle, Jr., Memorial Highway.

(c) Signs.—The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to traffic in both directions on the highway.

Section 2. Effective date.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.
