SECT. IV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, The townships of Patton and Warton and Warriormark, in Centre county, shall be annexed to the centre county. first election district; and the electors thereof shall hold their election to the first tions, with the electors of the townships of Spring and Centre, at election district. the place where the courts are held, in the town of Bellefont, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.
