CHAPTER 191.

LAW CONTINUING PRIOR LAWS.

Chap: 191 Be it Enacted that all those Laws made att Chester in the year 1682, Att Philadelphia in 1683, Att New castle in 1684, Att Philadelphia in 1685 and in the same place 1688 shall Continowe to stand in force, untill the rysing of the next generall Assemblie, and afterwards untill the publication of other Laws, which shall be past in the following generall Assemblie, except such Laws or part of Laws, which Shall by anie of these following Laws be repealed or such part of Laws, which are by any of the following Laws varied or added unto, except these following Laws viz Chapter 15, Selling of rum to the Indians: 20 Ryaters: 24 assault and batterie: 30 Scandalous reporters of false news: 33 price of beer and ale: 34 weights & measures: 43 bargains by evidence forfeit double: 48 Registrie about Servants: 49 factors and Correspondents to forfeit a third part: 51 Lands Lyable to pay debts: 56: The informer to have halfe the fine: 65: peace-makers.— 71 to forfeit five pounds that doth not prove his action: 75 Barretors: 78 Conveyances: 85 Cow-calves: 87 marking of horses & cattell 98: Custome of hyds: 104 hemp and flax Current pay: 116 Neglect of Counsellors giving their Attendance: 144 what of the Countrie growth shall pass for monie: 151 Accompts to be made up once a year 164 Stealing Live or dead goods: 170 deer skins to be exposed to Sale 172 Intestates, all which Laws here Last excepted Shall be and Continow untill the rysing of the next generall assembly and twentie dayes after, and no Longer; and that these following Chapters & paragraphs shall be taken as Additionall Laws of the province and Territories:

CHAPTER 192.

LAW REPEALING LAWS.

Chap: 192 That the 97 Law of Custom upon strong Liquors: the 98 of Custome upon hyds beavor and peltrie . . The 106 prohibiting provision imported to be exposed to sale befor the same had been five dayes in the province Or territories, The 152 about Buoys The 70 Law of Apealls to the Council, the 182 Concerning holding of provinciall Courts be and are hereby repealed:

CHAPTER 193.

LAW AMENDING LAWS.

Chap: 193 Be it enacted that in the 163d Law of registring the Names of free-men &c these words (and if anie person refuse or neglect to bring in the Names of his, her or their families to be registred as aforesaid within the time afore Limited, shall for the Said offence forfeit five shillings per head) be and are hereby repealed; And that these words in the 86 Chapter of Laws concerning the killing of wolves (and if anie Indian shall kill a wolfe and bring the head and bodie to a Justice of the peace, he shall have five shillings and the skin for his paines) And these words (Indians onlie excepted) be and are hereby repealed. That the reward therein Mentioned to be the same to an Indian, as is allowed to any other.
