
CHAPTER 122.

THE LAW ABOUT SALE OF INTESTATES LANDS BY THE WIDOW OR ADMINISTRATOR.

Be it Enacted by the authority aforesaid that any Person who dyed or that Shall dye Intestate being owner of lands within this Province or territoryes thereunto Belonging and hath left or Shall leave legal Issue It shall be lawfull for the widow or administrator in Case of Considerable debts Charge of Child or Children to make Sale of Such parts or tracts of the Said lands as the Councill or County Court Shall think meet towards the defraying of such just debts the education of such Child or Children support of the widow and the better Improveing the Remainder of the estate to their advantage
