CHAPTER 161.

THE LAW FOR CONFIRMING & CONTINUING THE LAWS OF THIS GOVERNMENT.

Be it Enacted by the Authority aforesaid That all the Laws heretofore made mentioned in the Petition of Right in the year 1693 And all the Laws made by the Same Sessions and Since, Are hereby enacted & declared to be the laws of the government — Except the Law Stiled the Frame of government made in the year 1696 And the Law about the Surveyor Generalls fees in the Petition of Right, and the Law about Attachments made in the year 1699 which are hereby declared void and repealed — And except such Laws or parts of Laws as are or shall be by the proprietor & Governor in the present Assembly repealed & declared void.
