CHAPTER CMLXXVI.

AN ACT TO REVIVE AND CONTINUE AN ACT, ENTITLED "AN ACT FOR OPENING AND KEEPING IN REPAIR THE PUBLIC ROADS AND HIGH-WAYS IN THIS PROVINCE." 1

(Section I, P. L.) Whereas, the act, entitled "An act for opening and keeping in repair the public roads and highways in this province,"¹ passed the twenty-first day of March, one thousand seven hundred and seventy-two, has expired by its own limitation, and whereas in its operation the said act hath proved beneficial and easy to the inhabitants and travelers in this state:

[Section I.] (Section II, P. L.) Be it therefore enacted by the Representatives of the Freemen of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and by the authority of the same, That the said act and every article, clause and thing therein contained, the clause for limitation only excepted, be and it is hereby declared to be revived and continued, and the same shall be and remain in full force and virtue for and during the term of five years from and after the passing of this act, and from thence to the end of the next sitting of assembly, and no longer.
