CHAPTER MMLXXXVI.

AN ACT TO CONTINUE FOR AN ADDITIONAL PERIOD, "AN ACT FOR INSTITUTING A BOARD OF PROPERTY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES THEREIN MENTIONED."1

Whereas an act, entitled, "An act to continue in force for a longer period," "An act for instituting a board of property, and for other purposes therein mentioned," passed the thirteenth day of January, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-four,² will expire with the present session.

[Section I.] (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the act, entitled, "An act for instituting a board of propery, and for other purposes therein mentioned," and every matter and thing contained therein, the limitation clause only excepted, shall be, and the same are hereby, continued to the thirtieth day of December, one thousand eight hundred and three, and from thence until the end of the session of the general assembly, and no longer.

CHAPTER MMLXXXVII.

An ACT FOR COMPLETING THE EDUCATION OF JOHN KONKAPOT, JR.

Whereas, on the twenty-fourth of March, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-seven, the legislature granted the sum of two hundred dollars for the education of John Konkapot, junior. And whereas it is judged expedient to complete the education of the said John Konkapot. Therefore:
