CHAPTER MMCXIV.

AN ACT TO CONTINUE AND MAKE PERPETUAL THE LAW, ENTITLED, "AN ACT FOR OPENING AND BETTER AMENDING AND KEEPING IN REPAIR THE PUBLIC ROADS AND HIGHWAYS WITHIN THIS PROV-INCE."

[Section I.] (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the act, entitled, "An act for opening and better amending and keeping in repair the public roads and highways within this province," passed the twentyfirst day of March, one thousand seven hundred and seventy-two,¹ and every thing and matter in the same act contained (the clause of limitation thereof only excepted) shall be, and the same is hereby, continued and made perpetual.

CHAPTER MMCXV.

AN ACT TO ERECT THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON, IN THE COUNTY OF FRANKLIN, INTO A SEPARATE ELECTION DISTRICT, AND TO REMOVE THE PLACE OF HOLDING THE ANNUAL ELECTIONS IN THE DISTRICT COMPOSED OF PLUM AND VERSAILLES TOWNSHIPS, IN THE COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY.

[Section I.] (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That, from and after the passing of this act, the township of Washington, in the county of Franklin,
